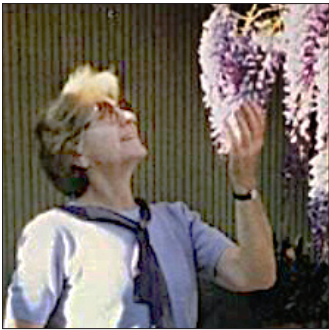
presents a very special Coffee In The Garden event at the

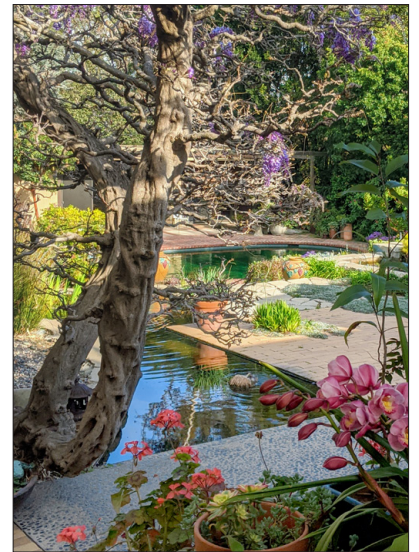


With her talents in art, design, entertaining and horticulture, the late Ruth Borun was the original “Mid-century Martha Stewart.” For over 50 years Ruth nurtured her garden, working with designers and her daughter, Nancy, to create a treasure that was featured in the Los Angeles Times, Sunset magazine and Christopher Lloyd’s book, *Other People’s Gardens*. She was a noted plant collector and hands-on gardener, with plenty of uncommon specimens abounding in her garden - many acquired from the late Gary Hammer.

We’ll be joined by groundbreaking (literally) landscape designer Christine Rosmini, who traveled with Ruth, visiting gardens throughout the world to help create the core structure of the current garden. Light refreshments will be served.



HISTORY: The original landscape architect of this garden in the 1960s was Garrett Eckbo, and it was reimagined in the 1980s by Chris Rosmini. The Borun garden is one of Rosmini’s pioneering Westside gardens - it is a sustainable (before the word was popular) landscape with a brand-new, distinctly Los Angeles style. She used climate-appropriate plants and is believed to be the first L.A. garden designer to artfully reuse a site’s broken concrete for walls and permeable paving.
